## Program Info

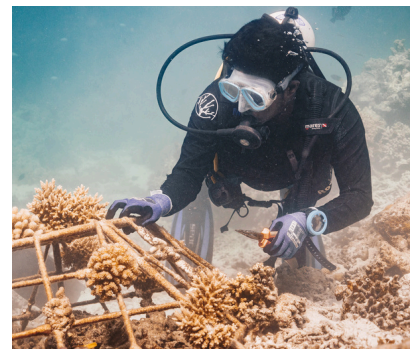
Join Coralive at our project location in the beautiful Maldives! In collaboration with our long-standing partner Oaga Art Resort, just 50 minutes from Malé, this program offers the perfect mix of theory and hands-on fieldwork. You will learn how to restore and protect coral reef ecosystems through activities such as setting up, populating and maintaining coral nursery structures, planting coral directly to the reef, monitoring reef health, and supporting education initiatives, all while enjoying fun dives in some of the Maldives' most beautiful waters.

We offer volunteer programs (minimum 2 weeks) to introduce you to marine conservation, as well as internships (minimum 3 months) that will develop your leadership potential, project management, and marine biology network.

### Duration & Start Dates:

Minimum: 2 weeks (Volunteer) or 3 Months (Intern)

Two start dates per month



## How to get involved

### Step 1

#### Create your personal Coral Profile

This helps us match you with the right program, dates and roles based on your previous experiences and level of education.



### Step 2

#### Let us know your Preference

Mention it in the profile and send an email to [volunteer@coralive.org](mailto:volunteer@coralive.org) with your preferred location, start date and duration.



### Step 3

#### Confirm your Spot

Our team will review profiles, set up interviews (for interns) and email you back with confirmation details, visa information, and pre-departure guidance.



### Step 4

#### Get Ready for your Adventure

Arrange your international flights to arrive on your program start date. Pack your diving gear, clothes, personal items and a whole lot of curiosity and excitement.



### Step 5

#### Arrive and dive right-in

Meet our representatives at the airport and transfer to the project location. Receive your orientation, settle in, and start making an impact!

## Your Programme

### Volunteers

- Create, expand and maintain reef nurseries and structures
- Harvest, handle and outplant corals from rope & table nurseries
- Learn about Mineral Accretion Technology (MAT)
- Collect and record reef health data & conduct corallivore surveys and interventions
- Initiate and expand your global conservation network

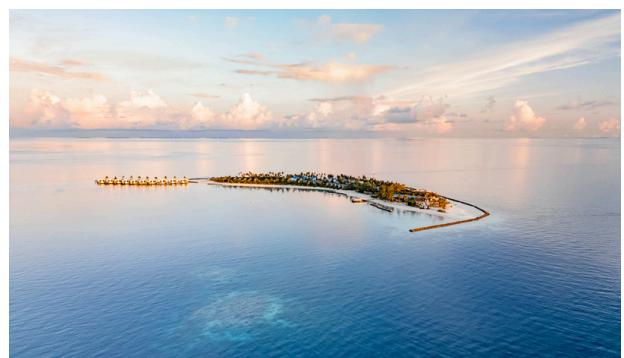
### Interns

- Initially learn from the 2-week volunteer programme and then;
- Learn to supervise and guide volunteers during fieldwork
- Lead underwater tasks and data collection
- Support scientific monitoring and reporting
- Take ownership of specific restoration or monitoring projects
- Generate and lead interactive guest activities

## Location Info

Our programme is based on Oaga Art Resort in North Malé Atoll, a 50 minute speed boat journey from the capital city, Malé. You will stay in staff accommodation (max. 4 share) and meals are provided at the staff canteen. Each programme also has the option to upgrade accommodation and meals.

Apart from your volunteer or internship experience, you'll get to embrace the Maldivian resort lifestyle. Spend your free time enjoying resort facilities, snorkelling, paddle boarding, or simply relaxing on the beach and soaking up the island's tranquility.
